Indoor applications often use Riser, Plenum, or Low Smoke Zero Halogen (LSZH) conduits, while outdoor or industrial settings may require UV-protected or corrosion-resistant materials . Flexible conduits allow routing around obstacles or moving machinery, whereas rigid conduits provide maximum mechanical protection .

Installation Considerations

When installing conduits within cable trays, it is important to avoid overfilling, as bundling multiple cables can cause heat buildup and require ampacity derating according to NEC Table 310.15(C)(1) . Conduits should be routed to minimize sharp bends and stress on cables, and they must comply with relevant standards such as NEC Articles 392 and 336 or IEC standards like IEC 61386 for conduit systems . Proper installation ensures long-term cable protection, reduces maintenance needs, and enhances safety in demanding environments .
