Cable Entry: Use knockouts or dedicated entry points on the terminal box to guide cables from the tray. Maintain the minimum bend radius for cables as they exit the tray to prevent damage. For instrumentation or control cables, consider using gland plates or bushings to protect against abrasion and maintain grounding continuity.

Fastening Accessories: Many junction boxes, such as OBO connectable boxes, offer variable fastening elements to attach directly to cable trays, allowing flexible and secure mounting. Use brackets, clamps, or tray adapters to ensure the box is mechanically stable and vibration-resistant.

Wiring Inside the Terminal Box Terminal Blocks: Use lever or screw-type terminal blocks to connect incoming cables from the tray to outgoing circuits. Pre-wired covers with plug-in systems (e.g., Wieland or Wago) can simplify installation and reduce wiring errors.

Segregation: Separate power, control, and data cables using barrier strips or partitions to prevent interference and comply with standards.

Labeling: Clearly label each terminal and cable for easy identification and maintenance.
