

Checking optical and electrical ports on a switch

Understanding Port Types

Optical ports require SFP or other optical modules to transmit data over fiber and support high-speed, long-distance connections (up to 100 km) with interface types like LC, SC, or MPO. Common speeds include 1.25G, 10G, 25G, 40G, and 100G. Electrical ports use RJ45 connectors for copper Ethernet cables, typically supporting speeds up to 10G and distances up to 100 meters, with Cat5e/Cat6 cables for 1G and Cat6A or higher for 10G connections.

Physical Inspection

LED Indicators: Check the port LEDs. Green usually indicates a normal link, while red or orange may indicate errors or a down link. A link light alone does not guarantee full functionality; frequent packet errors or flapping may indicate cable or port issues.

Cable and Connector Check: Ensure cables are properly seated, pins are intact, and patch panels or media converters are not faulty. Swap suspect cables or modules with known good ones to isolate the problem.

CLI Commands for Port Status

Cisco Switches:

- `show interface` : Displays port negotiation speed, link status (UP/DOWN), duplex, media type, and traffic statistics.
- `show interface status`: Lists all ports with their operational status.
- `show fiber-ports-optical-transceiver`: Provides optical module details, including transmit/receive power, temperature, and module type, useful for troubleshooting fiber links.

Extreme Switches: Query port and module status to monitor link connectivity, real-time Tx/Rx optical power, temperature, and DDM diagnostics. A "Normal" status indicates all parameters are within valid ranges.

Troubleshooting Tips

- Verify both ends:** Ensure the switch port and connected device are powered and properly configured.
- Bypass intermediaries:** Temporarily bypass pa...
