Function and Placement A level 3 distribution box serves as the final distribution point in a three-tier electrical system, connecting directly to end-use equipment such as power tools, lighting, or temporary machinery. It is typically installed under the secondary distribution board and can be either fixed or portable, depending on site requirements. Compliance with the principle of “one device, one circuit breaker, one RCD, one box”, preventing multiple devices from sharing a single protective circuit. Fire-resistant and durable enclosures, often made from technopolymer for portability and reuse on multiple sites.

Installation Considerations

- Power planning:** The box should be sized according to the project's power consumption plan; if unavailable, reference similar large-scale construction sites.
- Mounting:** Can be wall-mounted or installed on a support frame, ensuring stability and accessibility.
- Environmental protection:** Many tertiary boxes are IP-rated for dust and water resistance, suitable for outdoor or temporary site conditions.
- Coordination with upstream boards:** The tertiary box must be connected to the secondary distribution board, which in turn is fed from the main distribution board, ensuring proper load management and fault protection.
