5. Wiring Individual Circuits: Install and connect circuit breakers for each outgoing circuit. Label each breaker clearly. If using GFCI breakers or outlets, connect the incoming power to the Line terminals and only use Load terminals for downstream protection.
6. Compliance and Testing: Follow local electrical codes (e.g., NEC, IEC, or VDE standards) for installation. After wiring, perform insulation resistance tests, loop im...
