For straight pulls, the minimum length should be 8 times the trade size of the largest raceway, and for angle or U pulls, 6 times the largest raceway plus the sum of other raceways on the same wall.

Protection and Grounding Each cable circuit should have its own protection device, such as a breaker, fuse, or surge protector, to isolate faults and prevent damage. Ensure proper grounding and bonding of metallic boxes to maintain electrical continuity and safety. Verify that screws and fasteners do not damage conductors or compromise insulation.

Layout and Installation Considerations

Placement: Install distribution boxes in accessible, dry, and ventilated areas, typically at 1.2–1.5 meters height, with at least 1 meter of clearance around the box for maintenance.
