

Using the connection method of a mobile fiber optic switch

Ensure the cable type matches the transceiver module (single-mode or multimode). For direct attach cables (DACs), the SFP modules are pre-terminated, simplifying the connection.

Step 4: Connect the Transceiver Module Carefully insert the transceiver module into the designated port on the switch. Ensure it is fully seated and secure. Avoid touching the optical interface to prevent contamination.

Step 5: Connect the Fiber Optic Cable Attach the fiber optic cable to the transceiver module. For duplex connections, reverse the send and receive strands between switches (port A to port B and vice versa) to ensure proper signal flow. Clean the connectors before insertion to minimize signal loss.
