 - Multimode:** Use for short-distance links within data centers (OM1/OM2 = orange, OM3/OM4 = aqua, OM5 = lime green/violet).
- Polish Type:**
 - PC (Physical Contact):** Standard, reduces reflection.
 - UPC (Ultra Physical Contact):** Higher return loss, common in digital applications.
 - APC (Angled Physical Contact):** Angled end-face, minimizes back reflection, used in high-precision or analog systems.
- Duplex vs. Simplex:**
 - Duplex:** Two fibers for bidirectional communication, common in LC and SC connectors.
 - Simplex:** Single fiber, often used in PON or legacy systems.
- Environmental and Safety Requirements:**
 - PVC:** Standard indoor use.
 - LSZH (Low Smoke Zero Halogen):** Safer for confined spaces.
 - OFNP (Plenum):** Fire-resistant, required in air-handling spaces.
- Hybrid or Breakout Cables:** Used when connecting devices with different port types,...
