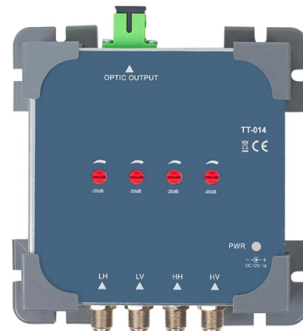


What is the normal power consumption of an industrial switch

- Environmental Conditions:** High temperatures or dusty environments can increase power draw due to cooling requirements.
- Energy Efficiency Features:** Switches compliant with IEEE 802.3az (Energy Efficient Ethernet) or with energy certifications can reduce power usage during low-traffic periods.

Calculating Total Power Requirements

To ensure sufficient power for an industrial switch setup:

- Determine Base Power:** Identify the switch's idle or static power consumption.
- Add PoE Load:** Sum the maximum power requirements of all connected devices.
