Cable Sizing and Selection For industrial sockets, the cable size depends on the current rating: 2.5 mm² for 16A, 6 mm² for 32A, and 16 mm² for 63A, using double-insulated copper cables for phase, neutral, and earth conductors . Lighting and standard socket circuits typically use 2.5 mm² wires, while air conditioning circuits may require 2.5 mm² or 4 mm² . Ensure cables are rated for the voltage (230V single-phase or 400V three-phase) and comply with insulation standards. Wiring Layout and Connection Incoming and outgoing wiring: Connect the main circuit breaker to branch circuit breakers on the left side of the distribution box, and route outgoing wires to sockets on the right . Connection method: Each switch or socket receives a wire from the incoming point; parallel connections can be used to simplify wiring . Conduit and protection: Use PVC or GI conduits to protect cables from physical damage. Conduits can be embedded in walls or mounted externally .
